- c. The court cannot identify a responsible adult to make educational decisions for the child, and the child is potentially eligible for special education and related services or already has an individualized education program. The local educational agency must notify the court of the identity of the appointee on attached form JV-536 within 21 calendar days of the date of the appointment, termination, or replacement of a surrogate parent.
- d. The court cannot identify a responsible adult to make educational decisions for the child, and the appointment of a surrogate parent is not legally warranted. The court, with input from any interested person, will make educational decisions for the child.
