1. Partner with Schools

- > Know what schools offer.
 - Ensure access to meals.
 - Ensure Access to school-related resources and services.
- Communicate regularly with schools.
 - Get current information from schools.
 - Provide current information to schools.
 - o Plan for post COVID-19 transitions.
- Continue or create new cross system collaborations and communication structures.
 - Tap existing school-agency collaborations.
 - Discuss key roles and responsibilities.
 - Work together at the systemic and individual levels.

2. Support the Education and Well-Being of Students in Foster Care

- ➤ Ensure the student has access to school materials and resource, including technology to benefit from remote learning opportunities.
 - Provide technology when needed.
 - Provide educational materials and supports when needed.
- > Ensure student's social/emotional needs are met.
- > Encourage school engagement.

3. **Support Caregivers**

- Provide information about school resources.
- Provide additional support to caregivers when needed.

4. Prioritize Students in Foster Care with Special Education Needs

- > Reach out to children with disabilities and their caretakers to determine supports needed.
- Work closely with schools to identify ongoing needs of students under IDEA.
- Clarify who is the child's education decision maker.
- > Reach out to the legal education advocacy community.
- Address the needs of young children birth through age 5.
